Their wines, like the iconic Cobos Malbec and Bramare, are rich, bold, and layered, offering dark fruit flavours like blackberry and plum, balanced by elegant tannins and a lingering finish. Each bottle reflects the power and finesse that the Malbec grape can achieve in the hands of a skilled winemaker. If you're looking to explore the heights of Argentine winemaking, Viña Cobos is a must-try.

Bramare - an Italian word meaning "to yearn". It symbolises the first step of Paul's dive into Mendocinian microsite exploration and terroir differentiation.

Their Felino brand characterises the lively qualities of the purest varietal expressions coming from Mendoza and are the perfect introduction to Argentinian terroir.
