THE STORY

Nestled in the heart of Sussex, Bolney Wine Estate stands as a testament to England's burgeoning reputation in the world of viticulture. Established in 1972 by Janet and Rodney Pratt, Bolney has evolved into a pioneer of English winemaking, seamlessly blending tradition with innovation.

The estate's vineyards flourish with classic grape varieties such as Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, and Pinot Meunier. These grapes are meticulously cultivated to produce an array of award-winning wines, including elegant sparkling whites, aromatic still whites, and distinctive reds. Notably, Bolney's sparkling wines have garnered acclaim for their finesse and complexity, reflecting the unique terroir of the Sussex countryside.

Grapes are hand-picked to ensure optimal ripeness and minimal damage, preserving freshness and aromatic intensity. Bolney's sparkling wines are made using the traditional method (Méthode Champenoise), with secondary fermentation occurring in the bottle and extended lees aging to develop richness and texture.

In January 2022, Bolney Wine Estate joined forces with Henkell Freixenet, a global leader in sparkling wines.
