THE STORY

Domaine Belleville, established in the early 20th century, is located in Rully, within Burgundy's Côte Chalonnaise region. The estate spans 18 hectares of vineyards, extending from Gevrey-Chambertin in the Côte de Nuits to Mercurey in the Côte Chalonnaise. Currently undergoing organic conversion, the domaine emphasises sustainable viticulture to express the unique terroir of each parcel.

In Rully, Domaine Belleville holds significant parcels in premier cru climats such as Les Cloux and Rabourcé, areas steeped in history dating back to the Gallo-Roman era. Their whites are noted for their expressive nature, featuring floral and citrus aromas, a ripe yet lean body, and a mineral-driven finish. These characteristics make them a compelling alternative to the more renowned (and often pricier) whites from the Côte de Beaune.

The estate's commitment to quality is evident in their meticulous vineyard management and winemaking practices, aiming to produce wines that authentically reflect their origin. As a result, Domaine Belleville has garnered attention as a noteworthy producer in Burgundy, offering wines that balance tradition with a forward-thinking approach to sustainability.
